Don't Forget that there is NO Membership Meeting in December.



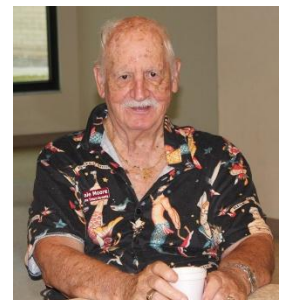

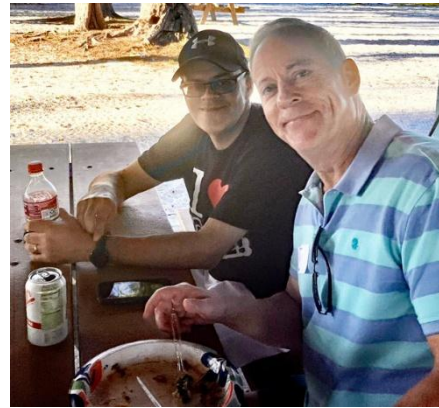
